

Introducing how a bracket works!

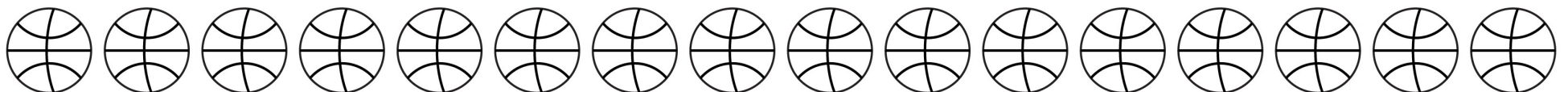
Many students are not familiar with how a bracket works. To show them before starting your March Madness Book Bracket have a tic-tac-toe tournament.

Draw names and create your bracket (if more than 16 students, create another quadrant with students).

Have students battle it out in tic-tac-toe, with winners moving on in the tournament. (Students who do not win can continue to play tic-tac-toe amongst themselves.)

Have the class watch during the “final four” and championship games.

This can also be done with rock-paper-scissors.
